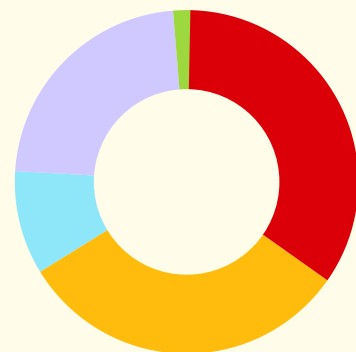

Revenue from Investments	2%

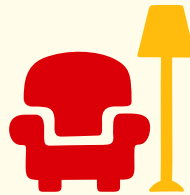
About us

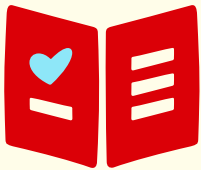
Our Houses
